Liability Insurance

It is the policy of the American Humanics AmeriCorps*ProCorps Program (AH ProCorps) that Host Sites hold adequate liability insurance coverage for the Host Site and its employees and other workers including coverage of the AH AmeriCorps*ProCorps member, as required by AC Provision V.E:1-2. Host Sites must comply with all federal, state, and local laws pertaining to workplace safety including those related to the provision of medical care. The Host Site bears full responsibility for any liability related to the work of the AH AmeriCorps*ProCorps member.

V. F. LIABILITY AND SAFETY ISSUES

- 1. Liability Insurance Coverage.** The grantee must have adequate liability insurance coverage for the organization, employees and members, including coverage of members engaged in on-and off-site project activities.
- 2. Member Safety.** The grantee must institute safeguards as necessary and appropriate to ensure the safety of members. Members may not participate in projects that pose undue safety risks.
