Public Notice of Nondiscrimination

It is against the law for organizations that receive financial assistance from the Corporation of National and Community Service to discriminate on the basis of, race, color, national origin, disability, sex, age, political affiliation, or in most cases religion. It is also unlawful to retaliate against a person who, or organization that, files a complaint about such discrimination. In addition to filing a complaint with local and state agencies that are responsible for resolving discrimination complaints, you may bring a complaint to the attention of the Corporation for National and Community Service.
